# **Recipe Corner:**

**Cranberry Oatmeal Cookies** 1 c. butter or margarine 2 eggs 1 c. brown sugar 1 tsp. vanilla  $\frac{1}{2}$  c. sugar soda  $1\frac{1}{2}$  c. flour 1 c. cranberries

- 1 tsp. baking 1 tsp. cinnamon  $\frac{1}{2}$  tsp. salt (opt)
- 3 c. oatmeal nuts
- $\frac{1}{2}$  c. chopped

Soften cranberries in warm water and drain. Beat together butter and sugars until creamy. Add eggs & vanilla, beat well. Add flour, baking soda, cinnamon and salt, mix well. Stir in oatmeal, cranberries and nuts, mix well. Drop by teaspoon full onto cookie sheet. Bake for 10-12 minutes at 350 degrees.
