There are several trails that will take one to Grenora. Some of them are paved with asphalt. Some of them are relatives or friends that beckon, but all of them are interesting to the eye and the heart.

I took one of those trails. It was the road that went by West Prairie Lutheran Church. That road took me over several ridges and into many a fine valley. One of the valleys harbored the beginnings of Cow Creek. I can imagine how it got its name. Sunny Sherbet Slush

- 1 6 ounce can frozen orange juice
- 1 6 ounce can frozen lemonade


