There are several trails that will take one to Grenora.

I took one of those trails. It was the road that went by West Prairie Lutheran Church. That road took me over several ridges and into many a fine valley. One of the valleys harbored the beginnings of Cow Creek. I can imagine how it got its name. When you looked over the valley you got the impression that creek had been working over that valley for some time.

I met an interesting poet that lives by the headwaters of Cow Creek. She can write of God's work in about any place she is put. She can pick words right out of the air; a mystery that befuddles me, her eye reveals. I can't figure it out, but it probably has something to do with Cow Creek running through that gentle valley, or it is simply a gift that God has given her.

The eye of faith is something like that. It sees things differently than the unbelieving eye. Two brothers can look at the same thing and see something entirely different. That's why when I came over the ridge at Cow Creek and saw that antlered elk grazing at the edge of the creek I marveled, simply marveled, at the work of God right on the road to Grenora. It's no wonder a poet lives up there. Have you seen it? Or is it just another road?

Recipe Corner Sunny Sherbet Slush

- 1 6-ounce can frozen orange juice
- 1 6-ounce can frozen lemonade
