Concordia Veterans Memorial

At the last annual meeting of Cemetery
Association a long range goal to add a flag pole
to honor our military heroes in our cemetery was
discussed. The Hanson family has come
forward with a major memorial gift to provide the
flag pole and base for a memorial.

It is our hope that others will join with us and
provide funds so we can secure a granite
memorial that will have the names of all the
veterans in our cemetery inscribed as a
permanent memorial to our veterans. (New
veteran names may be added each year.)
To complete this project we will need to raise
about \$3,000.00. If you would like to join in this
effort see next page for details.

- 1) Contributions will first to go to providing the granite monument for listing names of Veterans.
- 2) Plans also include adding a matching granite bench. This would provide an opportunity for a family to sponsor with a special inscription or family name. The matching bench would be \$1,200.00
