

Recipe Corner

Pina Colada Cake

Irene Olson brought this cake to the Ice Cream Social in July.

1 box white cake mix

3 egg whites

1/3 cup oil

1 1/4 cups water

1(20 oz) can crushed pineapple-drained (reserve juice)

1 can sweetened condensed milk

1 (10 oz) can frozen pina colada mix- thawed

1 (12oz) tub of cool whip

1 cup flaked coconut- toasted

Mix cake according to directions. Stir in ½ of the drained pineapple. When mixed, pour into a greased 9X13 cake pan. Bake for 35-40 minutes at 350 degrees. Meanwhile in a medium bowl combine reserved pineapple juice, sweetened condensed milk, and pina colada mix. When cake is done, remove from oven, using a knife, poke holes over the entire cake, do not go all the way to the bottom. Pour pina colada mixture over the entire cake. Place cake in refrigerator for several hours or overnight. In another bowl mix cool whip and remaining pineapple together, spread over top of cake. Sprinkle with toasted coconut.


