Lent is a season in the church year that is dedicated to contemplating the radical nature of Christ's life and death. The mystery of divine

suffering and the necessary event of the death of the divine have inspired not only theologians and pastors but also poets, musicians and artists to push the boundaries of human ingenuity in the attempt to plumb the depths/capture the essence and emotional impact of the events of Jesus' life leading up to and including Holy Week. There are many ways humans

have sought to explore this great mystery; most recently it has included drama. We have utilized drama at Concordia before drawing upon congregational volunteers to participate. Given that the word "liturgy" literally means (in Greek) "the work of the people" it is appropriate to have lay people involved in worship.

This year we will be using the liturgical drama, <u>Convicted</u>. It is a themed Lenten series that includes full worship liturgies that enable the congregation to step into a court room for Ash Wednesday and the following five weeks of Lent. Each *Convicted* service puts a different Biblical person on trial, accused of a 21st century crime pertaining to their role in the events leading up to Jesus' crucifixion. An overall guiding question leads the arguments of each case while the congregation serves as the jury.

All are welcome to be a part of this year's Wed evening events which start March 6 with a simple supper at 5:00 followed by worship.

## Recipe of the Month Roots and Rice Soup



#### Ingredients

- 8 cups water
- 4 beef bouillon cubes
- $1 \ 1/2 \ \text{cups rice}$
- $2\ {\rm cups}\ {\rm turnips},$  peeled and diced
- $1\ \mathrm{cup}\ \mathrm{parsnips},$  peeled and diced
- 1 large potato, peeled and diced
- $\frac{1}{2}$  cup grated carrots
- $\frac{1}{2}$  cup chopped onions
- 1 chopped garlic clove
- Salt & pepper

#### Directions

- Place all ingredients in a large pot, bring to a boil over high heat.
- Cover and simmer for 25-40 minutes, or until turnips, parsnips and potatoes are tender.
